## Dave's Rolls Royce Resto Rod

The next step on Dave Selmeski's street rod project. I met Bev at Roger Brown's wood working shop to see the progress on finishing the body of the 1935 Rolls Royce. For those not familiar with



the project. Dave started the conversion of a Rolls Royce that had a bad engine, among other things, into a street rod a long time ago. Not sure but from what Bev told me I would guess it was around 40 years ago. Dave was having a custom woody body made for it at a shop in Alabama. After Dave's death it was retrieved and taken to Roger Brown's to finish the

body. All the sheetmetal still needs to be restored and installed including running boards and front and rear fenders. Needs a complete interior and the fabric roof insert made and installed. It has a Jaguar front suspension and a truck rear end with disc brakes, a 454 Chevrolet engine with a Turbo 400 behind it. Bev is still trying to decide what the next step should be and if one of her sons wants it or it will be sold.

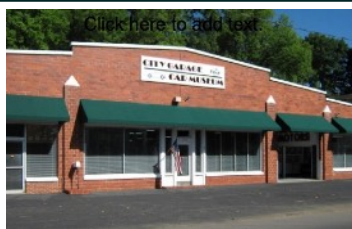
